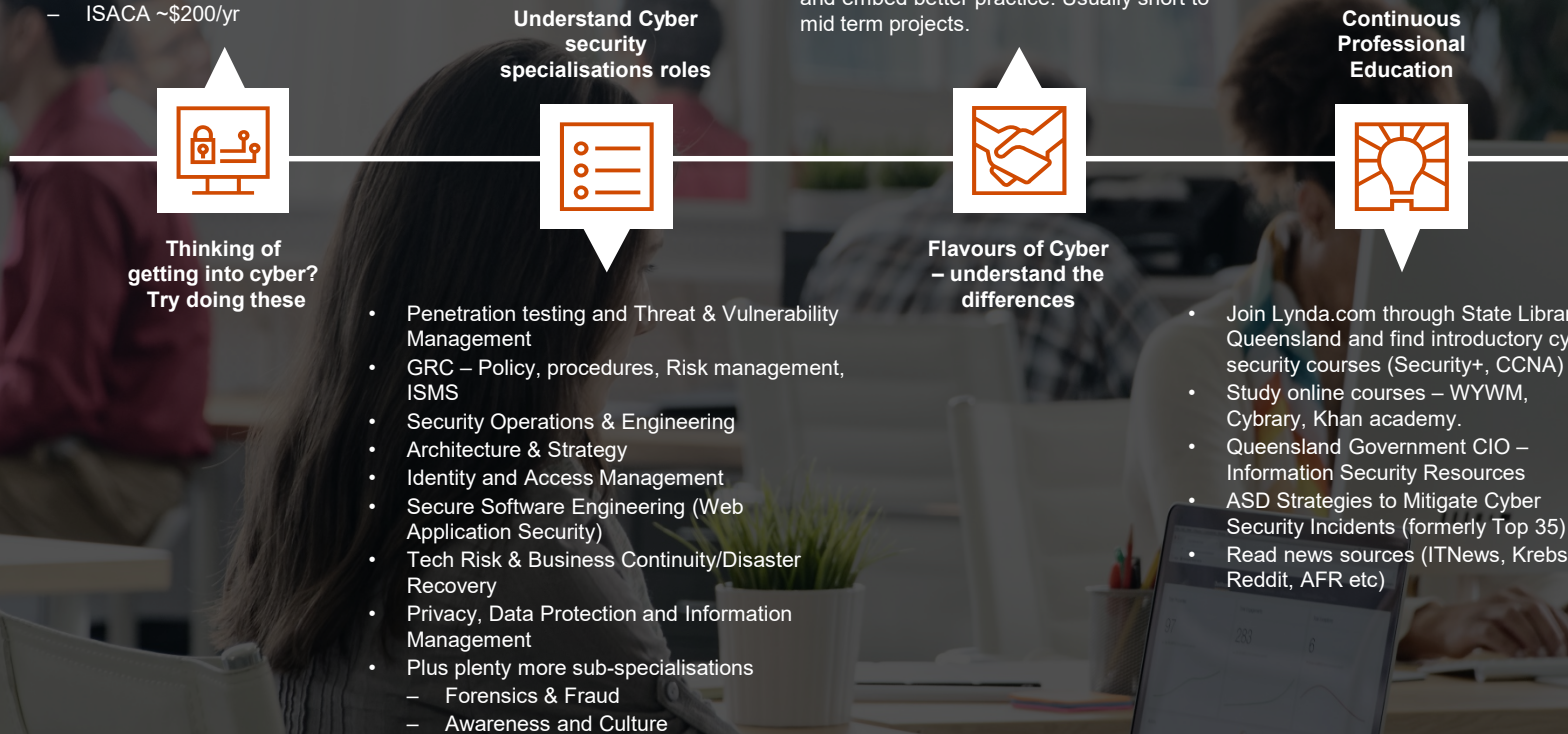


- Join free meetups – Cyber Risk Meetup, SecTalks, Brisbane Cyber Security Meetup.

- Consider studying for entry level certs such as CISA, CoBIT, Security+, CEH, vendor certs, ITIL.
- Understand general cyber frameworks and standards (NIST, ISO, ASD etc)
- Join industry bodies which give you access to free monthly lunch and learns plus other opportunities

- **Working in Industry:** Working in an internal client security team, noting different industry verticals such as:
 - Government
 - Financial Services
 - Infrastructure and Utilities
 - Health & Human Services
- **Working in Contracting:** Working as a sole service provider on a daily rate, typically project oriented. Usually mid to long term projects.
- **Working in Professional Services:** Project based consulting with clients to help them identify gaps and embed better practice. Usually short to mid term projects.



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
